User survey about library search


We conducted a Qualtrics survey over a 2-week period during the Spring of 2022.

Our goals:


- We wanted to learn about users' familiarity with and use of the Other Resources pull-down located on our homepage near the search box.
- For Primo VE, we wanted to learn about:
 - Users' familiarity with the top menu bar and post search facets.
 - How users navigate multiple resource links appearing on a full record.
 - Users' ability to request a physical journal volume.
 - Users' familiarity and perceived value of the Library Search guide.
- 161 people completed the survey.
- Gift cards to a local bookstore were used as incentives to encourage participation; we were able to offer 10 gift cards (3 staff, 5 undergraduates, and 2 graduate students)


Other resources pull-down use.




Resource use in the homepage pull-down.

Stacked 161 Responses




Primo VE facets



Primo VE facet use.



Outcomes from survey

- The Discovery Steering Group is still reviewing the results.
- The pull-down on the homepage was removed with the resources now appearing by default.
- The Primo VE facets are under review: which facets should appear, their order and which facet values should be shown by default and how many. Primo VE analytics will be used with the user feedback from the survey.
- Review of electronic resource activations determines whether they appear in Primo VE.
